

## Castle Hill Public School Band Program – 2019

Dear Parents,

Welcome back, and a very special welcome to our new students and parents! We are looking forward to another great year of making music.

Correspondence will be via email. Please ensure this is your most up to date email address and notify TSA if you change it or would like additional parents/guardians added to our contact list.

### NEW BEGINNERS *(those learning an instrument for the first time in 2019)*

There are two components to the Band Program: Group lessons and a Full Band rehearsal both held on the same day.

#### **Group Lessons:**

- Start Wednesday 6 February (bring Instrument and *Accent On Achievement* book. Any items ordered through TSA will be distributed in the first lesson.) This first lesson will focus on showing new students how to set-up and care for their instruments.
- Lessons will take place each Wednesday between **3:00-4:00pm** at school
- Students will be allocated a 30min group during this time, and TSA Director, Mrs Lucia Bichara, will contact parents directly via email with allocated lesson times prior to school resuming

#### **Full Band Rehearsal:**

- Beginners will not be required at band rehearsal until **Week 6 (6 March)**. Training Band rehearsals will take place on Wednesday at **7:45am** in the school hall.

### EXISTING BAND STUDENTS *(those who already learned an instrument in 2019)*

#### **Group Lessons:**

- Start Wednesday 6 February. A timetable will be emailed to you prior to school resuming.

#### **Full Band Rehearsal:**

- Starts Wednesday 6 February in the school hall
- Bring instrument & pencil, *Accent on Achievement* book and band folder
- CONCERT BAND 3-3:50pm in the school hall
- PERFORMANCE BAND 4-4:50pm in the school hall

## IMPORTANT ITEMS

**Fees** – In 2019, band and tuition fees will be \$190 per term plus a \$15 facility hire fee and \$5 TSA resource levy per term. TSA will email invoices at the beginning of each school term and your invoice needs to be finalised within 2 weeks of issue or late fees will apply.

**Absence from Band** – if your child will be absent from band or lessons please be sure to contact your child's band director to notify them of this absence. In particular, absences to rehearsals or tuition outside of school hours must be communicated clearly so TSA can confirm your child is safe and accounted for.

**Creative Kids Vouchers** – TSA is a registered provider and all families can apply for their \$100 voucher by visiting [www.service.nsw.gov.au/creativekids](http://www.service.nsw.gov.au/creativekids). The voucher may be used at any time in 2019.

**Exiting the Band Program** – TSA requires notice by the end of any term if your child wishes to exit from the program in the next term.
