

Northmead High School Band Program – 2025

Dear Parents,

Welcome back, and a very special welcome to our new students and parents! We are looking forward to another great year of making music. Correspondence will be via email: please ensure TSA has your current email address and check your junk/spam folder for communications.

BAND STRUCTURE

There are two components to the Band Program: sectional tutorials and a full band rehearsal. Both of these are held on Monday afternoons from 2:30pm-4:00pm and students are required to attend for the full duration of this session.

Private (individual) tuition is available on all instruments for those looking for extra help keeping up or extension opportunities. These lessons can take place during the day (students come out of class) or there are some (limited) spots available after rehearsal. Private tuition is an additional expense (see below) and places are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Contact band director Joshua McNulty for further information

Band will commence for 2025 on Monday 10 February. Please ask your child to bring their instrument along with a black, A4 plastic sleeved display folder. Students should meet in Room 82 straight after school.

SUPERVISION AND DISMISSAL

Students will be supervised during band time by TSA staff and will be dismissed at 4:00pm.

IMPORTANT ITEMS

Fees – In 2025, band fees (rehearsals + sectionals) will be \$230 per term plus \$10 resource levy. Private tuition (optional) costs \$510 per term plus a band rehearsal fee of \$115/term plus \$10 resource levy. TSA will email invoices/process direct debits at the beginning of each school term, and payment needs to be finalised within 2 weeks of issue or late fees will apply.

Absence from Band – if your child will be absent from band or lessons please notify the band director. Absences outside of school hours must be communicated clearly so we can confirm your child is safe and accounted for.

Creative Kids Vouchers – TSA is a registered provider and families with Creative Kids Vouchers can apply them to term fees by entering voucher details via the TSA website here: <https://teachingservices.com.au/creative-kids/>.

Exiting the Band Program – TSA requires notice by the end of any term if your child wishes to exit from the program in the next term.
